**Prenatal through Three
Years Old**

The Salida Early Childhood Center offers a home based program for families interested in partnering with a home visitor to navigate the journey of parenting.

- * Services are provided prenatally as well as for families with children from birth to three years old.
- * Weekly visits consist of activities and support based on your child's current development and your family's interests.
- * Home visits continue until your child is eligible to enter the center based program, and your family feels ready.
- * Topics Include: Prenatal health and attachment (If applicable), social emotional development, physical and brain development, language, literacy, basic care, play, family culture, and stress management.
- * The home visitor's role is to use best practices to support your family in a way that values and honors every member's perspective and viewpoint.
- * Opportunity to participate in home based gatherings, gain links to community resources, and receive support in accessing ongoing care.
