At least 38/22 unique community partner sites engaged/distributed materials*

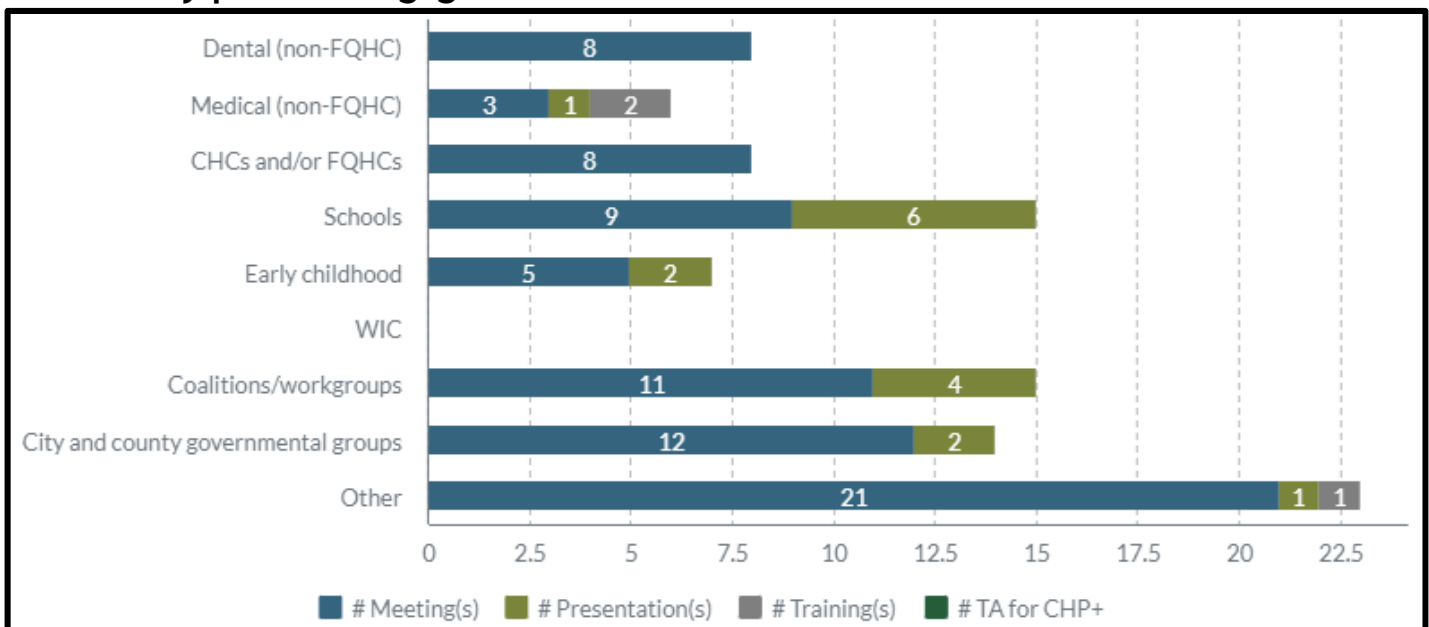

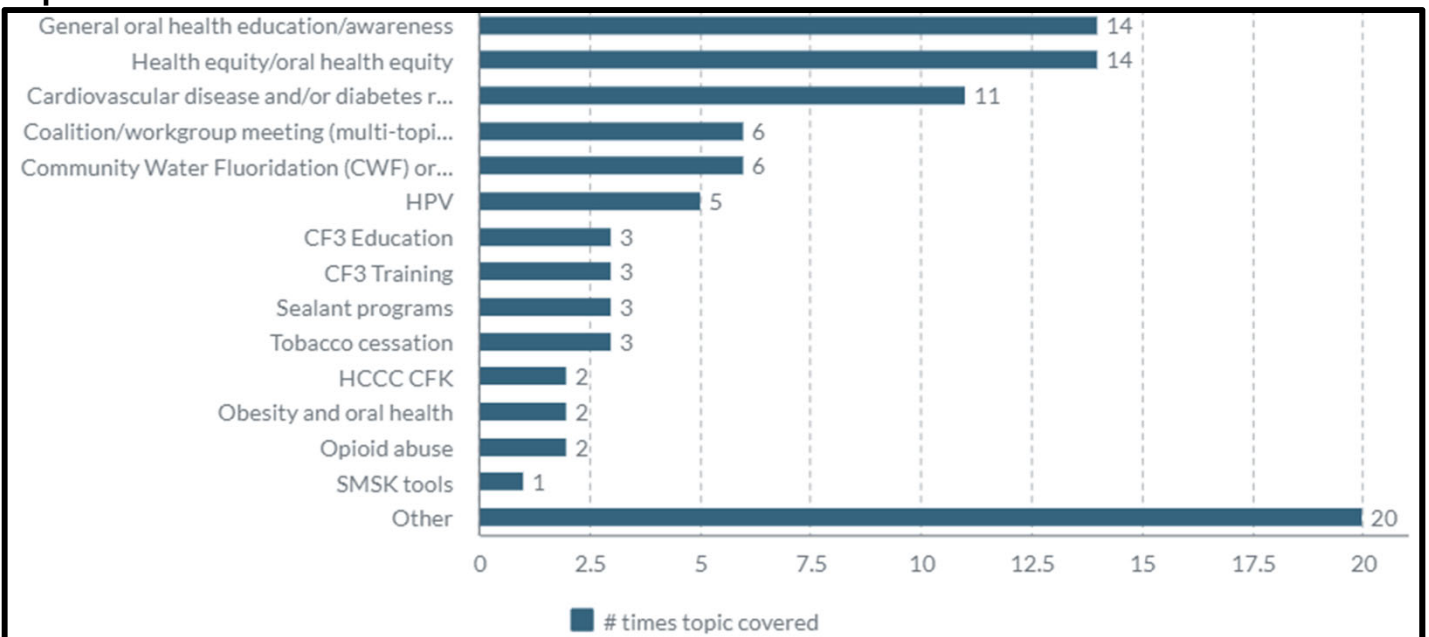

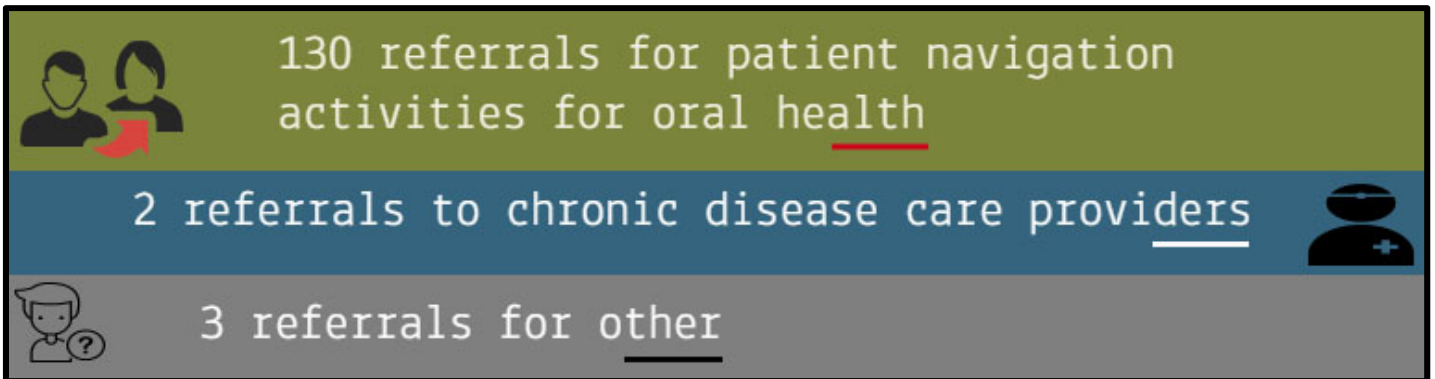

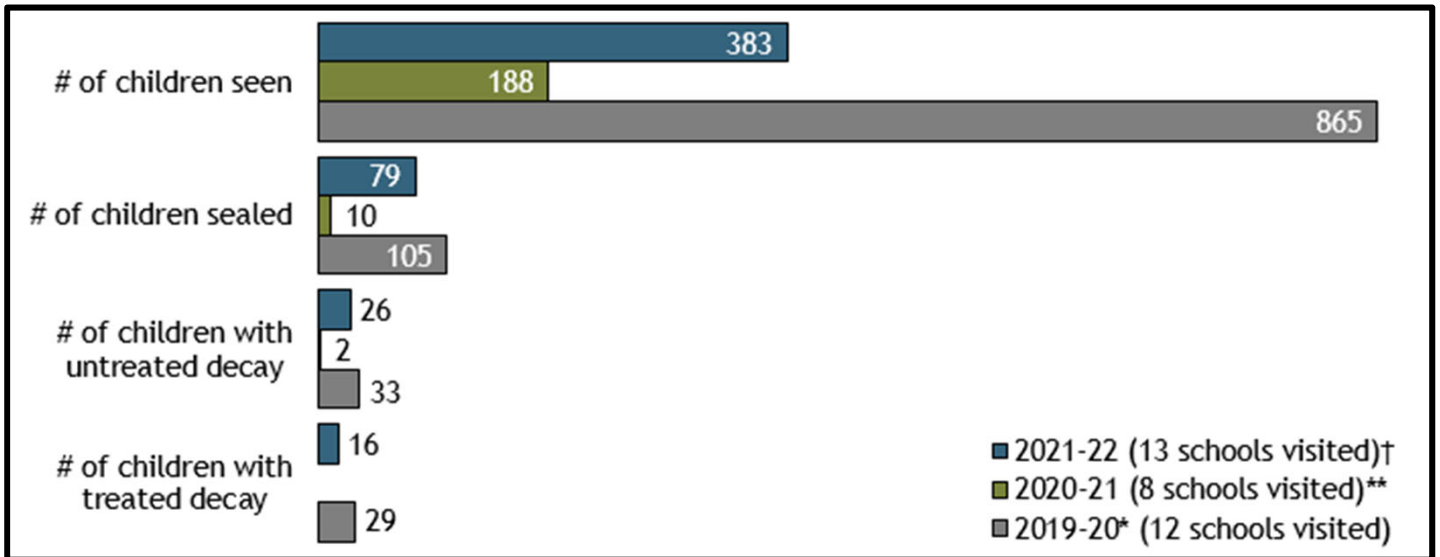

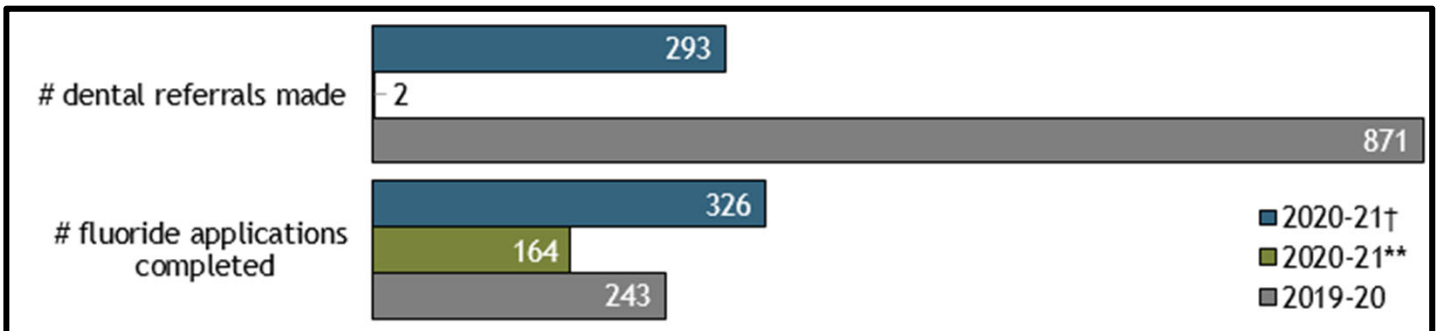
